CESSATION OF VIDEO SERVICE**

On January 18, 2016, Kingdom Telephone Company, (“Kingdom”) filed a notice informing the Commission of the cessation of video service in the following political subdivisions:

Auxvasse
Mokane
Rhineland
Audrain County
Callaway County
Montgomery County

Kingdom is no longer providing video service in the above-listed political subdivisions, nor any other political subdivisions in the State of Missouri.

The Commission has reviewed the notice filed by Kingdom and finds that in accordance with Section 67.2685, RSMo 2000, the video service authorizations for the above-listed political subdivision will expire and shall be removed from Kingdom’s video franchise service area.


**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**
