On May 2, 2016, Cable One, Inc., (“the Company”) pursuant to Section 67.2679.7, RSMo (Cum. Supp. 2013), filed an application for video service authorization in the following political subdivision:

2. Cable One, Inc. is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.
