**MISSOURI PROPANE GAS ASSOCIATION’S RESPONSE
TO SUMMIT NATURAL GAS OF MISSOURI, INC.’S REQUEST FOR MEDIATION**

COMES NOW the Missouri Propane Gas Association (MPGA), by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby responds to Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.’s (SNGMO) Request for Mediation pursuant to the Commission’s November 4, 2015 Order.

1. MPGA consents to the request for mediation.
2. MPGA has no objection to a suspension of the date of filing of an answer until such time as mediation is can be scheduled and conducted.
3. In its request, SNGMO stated that it has no objection to MPGA’s Motion for Leave, but requests that if the motion is granted, it be relieved from filing an answer to the initial Complaint, and indicates that by rule, its answer to the First Amended Complaint would not be due until ten days after the Commission grants the Motion for Leave and the First Amended Complaint is deemed filed with the Commission. MPGA has no objection to SNGMO’s requests in this regard and renews its Motion for Leave.
4. If the Commission chooses to grant the request for mediation, MPGA would not be able to participate on the following dates in 2015 because of conflicts:
 - November 17, 18, and 30;

- December 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 17, 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30, and 31.
