**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Charter Communications Entertainment I, LLC, d/b/a Charter Communications is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of each political subdivision set forth in the notice of change application and restated above; and
2. Charter Communications Entertainment I, LLC, d/b/a Charter Communications is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance, after which this case may be closed.
