In the matter of The approval of Batson Development Company, for permission, approval and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system and a water system for the public, located in an unincorporated area in Butler County, Missouri.

ORDER

By a Report and Order issued herein, effective on the 19th day of July, 1979, the Commission granted to Batson Development Company a conditional certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the construction, installation, ownership and operation of a sanitary sewage disposal system and a water system in unincorporated areas of Butler County, Missouri.

The conditional certificate required the Applicant to furnish satisfactory proof that all necessary operating permits have been obtained for the water and sewer systems, that the water and sewer lines, including the respective plants, have been conveyed to Batson Development Company, and that a tariff, rules and regulations for the operation of the water and sewer companies have been filed for approval of the Commission.

The Applicant has previously filed its tariffs with the Commission. On February 9, 1981, the Applicant filed with the Commission copies of the required conveyances and permits from the Department of Natural Resources.

Since the Applicant has complied with all of the conditions, previously established, the Commission is of the opinion that the conditional certificates, previously granted, should be made permanent.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the conditional certificates, previously issued in this matter, granting permission to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain the sanitary sewage disposal system and a water system in unincorporated areas of Butler County, Missouri, be, and the same are, hereby made permanent.



ORDERED: 2. That this Order small become affective on the date hereof.
