## MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L"), by and through counsel, and for its Motion For Extension Of Time For Filing Staff Recommendation states as follows:

1. On December 8, 2009, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L" or the "Company") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") an <u>Application</u> seeking authority to issue up to \$650 million principal amount of debt securities through December 31, 2011, and to enter into interest rate hedging instruments in connection therewith.

2. On February 2, 2010, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing which ordered the Staff to file its Staff Recommendation in this matter by February 17, 2010.

3. KCP&L and Staff are continuing to discuss issues related to the Company's
