**MOTION OF U.S. CELLULAR FOR LEAVE TO FILE  
SCHEDULE OUT OF TIME**

Applicant USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC, d/b/a U.S. Cellular, hereby requests leave of the Commission under 4 CSR 240-2.015 to refile Schedule NW-6 attached to the Surrebuttal Testimony of Nick Wright out of time. In support of this Motion, U.S. Cellular states as follows:

1. Attached is Schedule NW-6 which is a website screen shot of the Verizon Wireless Network Map which shows that company's Missouri coverage. Due to an administrative error, the Schedule NW-6 which was filed with the Surrebuttal Testimony of Nick Wright was a website screen shot of the Verizon Wireless America's Choice map.

2. 4 CSR 240-2.130(8) requires that no party can supplement testimony unless ordered by the presiding officer or the Commission. However, the Commission for good cause may waive such a rule under 4 CSR 240-2.015.

3. As this Schedule is being submitted within 24 hours from the date that the Surrebuttal Testimony of Mr. Wright was filed at the Commission, U.S. Cellular believes that good cause exists for granting leave to file the correct Schedule one day out of time and that it be considered as attached to Mr. Wright's Surrebuttal Testimony and replacing Schedule NW-6 which was filed on October 3, 2005.

WHEREFORE, U.S. Cellular requests that the Commission permit the filing of Schedule NW-6 one day out of time and that it be considered as if it were attached to the Mr. Wright's Surrebuttal Testimony which was filed on October 3, 2005.
