Although the Commission has not approved the Agreement, 45 days have passed since the Agreement was filed. The Commission will therefore require the Director to file a pleading, informing the Commission of whether these two conditions in the Agreement have been met.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission shall file a pleading informing the Commission of whether America's Home Brokers, Inc., has corrected all deficiencies noted in the complaint to the satisfaction of the homeowners and the Director.

2. That the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission shall file a pleading informing the Commission of whether America's Home Brokers, Inc., has corrected or resolved the deficiencies noted in three additional inspection reports that were prepared since the filing of this case before the Commission.

3. That the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission shall file the pleadings described in ordered paragraphs 1 and 2 no later than June 30, 2005.

4. That this order shall become effective on June 14, 2005.
