**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

On March 9, 2010, the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, filed his notice of dismissal of this case, based on his knowledge and belief that Brookside and Steven D. Warren, a named respondent when the complaint was filed, are no longer selling or distributing new manufactured homes. The Director previously dismissed Mr. Warren from the complaint on October 5, 2009, and the Commission acknowledged that dismissal.

As provided in 4 CSR 240-2.116, the complainant in a matter may voluntarily dismiss a complaint by filing notice of the dismissal prior to any evidence being offered or prepared testimony being filed. No testimony has been filed and no oral evidence has

been offered. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges the Director's voluntary dismissal of this case and closes the case.
