On May 12, 2014, American Broadband and Telecommunications Company d/b/a American Assistance filed a motion for a protective order. American Assistance states that the information it has filed, and will be filing in this matter, is not publicly available, and that the applicant would suffer significant negative business consequences if that information were to be made public. American Assistance therefore requests a protective order, subject to the terms of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.135, authorizing continued confidentiality of the information attached to its application and similar information that may be provided with other pleadings in this case.

Because it is reasonable, the Commission will grant the requested relief.

1. American Broadband and Telecommunications Company d/b/a American Assistance's motion for a protective order is granted.
