MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission; Office of the Public Counsel; Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Midwest Energy Consumers Group; Consumers Council of Missouri; and Sierra Club ("Parties"), and for their *Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* states:

- 1. On March 29, 2023, the Parties engaged in settlement discussions. As a result of those discussions, a settlement in principle has been reached on all issues that would affect the revenue requirement in this case, leaving only Issue 4 (including all subparts), Issue 24.B (Issue 24.A is resolved), and Issue 30 reserved for hearing.¹ The Parties are working towards finalizing a stipulation and agreement that will memorialize the above-referenced settlement in principle.
- 2. In anticipation of settlement, the Parties have authorized Ameren Missouri's counsel to file this motion requesting the Commission modify the procedural schedule ordered by it on September 28, 2022, as follows:
 - Cancel hearings from April 3, 2023 April 7, 2023, and cancel hearings on April 10 and 11, 2023.
 - Reschedule Issue 4 to begin on April 12, 2023 (a portion of April 13, 2023, could be used to finish Issue 4, if needed).
 - Reschedule Issues 24.B and 30 for April 13, 2023.

Reserve April 14, 2023, if necessary, to complete the reserved issues.

Eliminate the requirement that a Reconciliation be filed on March 30,

2023, insofar as none of the reserved issues affect the revenue requirement.

3. Intervenors in the above-styled case not included in this motion have been

given notice of the settlement in principle.

4. This Motion was filed as soon as it could have been under the circumstances

given that the settlement in principle was just agreed upon today. Granting this Motion will

benefit the Commission and the parties by conserving resources, including hearing time and

expense, and avoiding unnecessary proceedings. There will be no negative effect on the

Company's customers or the general public. The Parties request the Commission act on this

Motion by Noon, March 30, 2023, given the current deadline for submitting the Reconciliation

that is no longer necessary.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri, on behalf of itself, the Staff of the Commission,

Office of the Public Counsel, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, Midwest Energy

Consumers Group, Consumers Council of Missouri, and Sierra Club requests the Commission

issue an order modifying the procedural schedule in this case as requested above, and for such

other and further relief as the Commission deems just in the circumstances.
