APPLICATION OF MPOWER COMMUNICATIONS CORP. TO SURRENDER ITS CERTIFICATES TO PROVIDE BASIC LOCAL AND INTRASTATE INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

COMES NOW, Mpower Communications Corp. ("Mpower"), by and through counsel, and in support of its Application to Surrender its Certificates to Provide Basic Local and Intrastate Interexchange Telecommunications Services, states as follows:

- 1. On March 22, 2000, the Commission issued its Order in Docket No. TA-2000-453 granting Mpower a Certificate of Service Authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
- 2. On July 20, 2000, the Commission issued its Order in Docket No. TA-2000-812 granting Mpower a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
- 3. As the Commission is aware, the competitive telecommunications industry has seen many changes in the past three years. As a result of those changes, Mpower has sought to concentrate its geographic footprint. Included in this effort was a decision to exit the local exchange market in Missouri in 2001. Mpower no longer maintains a network in Missouri and does not have any customers in the state of Missouri.
- 4. Since it no longer operates in Missouri, Mpower no longer desires to maintain its certificate in the state. As such, Mpower seeks to surrender its certificate.

WHEREFORE, Mpower respectfully requests that the Commission issue its

Order granting Mpower's request to surrender its certificates to provide basic local and
intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.
