

STATEMENT OF POSITION

Comes Now the Missouri School Boards’ Association (hereinafter “MSBA”), by and through counsel, RSBIII, LLC, Richard S. Brownlee, III, files its Statement of Position in the above referenced matter. In support of its position, MSBA states the following:

1. MSBA’s position is to approve new tariff language which accomplishes:
 - (a) Consistent pipeline transportation capacity release tariff language for both Spire East and Spire West pipelines.
 - (b) Capacity release quantity to be based on the maximum daily usage during the most recent rolling seven-years instead of since 2002.
 - (c) Reflect the addition of the Spire StL pipeline for the Spire East area as another choice in addition to the MRT pipeline.
 - (d) Capacity price to be at Spire’s cost to conform with the special school statute Section 393.310 RSMo.
