ORDER AND NOTICE OF CHANGE  
IN  
TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING

By order issued on the 1st day of September, 1978, the Commission set  
this matter for hearing in its hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson  
State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri, at 10:00 AM on October 19, 1978.

On September 22, 1978, the Commission received a petition from the  
occupants of 31 residences in Ecology Acres Subdivision expressing concern over the  
high rate proposal of the Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc., and requesting a local  
hearing before the final rate structure is determined.

The Commission is of the opinion that the opportunity requested should be  
afforded and that for convenience the entire hearing should be held in the City of  
Dexter, Missouri.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the schedule for hearing in this matter previously  
announced in the Commission's order of September 1, 1978, be, and the same is,  
hereby canceled, and that the hearing shall be held between the hours of 2:00 PM and  
8:00 PM on Thursday, October 19, 1978, in the basement meeting room of Security  
Federal Savings and Loan Association, 310 North Walnut Street, Dexter, Missouri.
