STAFF'S MOTION TO EXTEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its motion states:

1. The Commission adopted the parties' proposed procedural schedule calling for the filing of a stipulation of facts on December 2, 2005, and for the filing of all parties' briefs on December 23, 2005.

2. Preparing a stipulation of facts has taken longer than anticipated. The parties are engaged in the processes of writing, reviewing, and revising a draft stipulation of facts. Time Warner Cable has authorized the Staff to state that Time Warner Cable does not object to a two-week extension of the procedural schedule.

3. The Commission may, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.050(3), extend filing dates.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests an extension until December 16, 2005, for the parties to file a stipulation of facts and until January 6, 2006, for the parties to file their briefs.
