ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
EXTEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 18, 2005, the Commission issued its order requiring the filing of a proposed procedural schedule. On November 10, after receiving an extension of time, the Staff of the Commission filed its Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule. The Commission granted Staff's request, and ordered the parties to file a stipulation of facts no later than December 2, and briefs no later than December 23.

On December 2, Staff filed a Motion to Extend Procedural Schedule. In that motion, Staff explained that preparing the stipulation has taken longer than expected. Staff asks for an additional two weeks to prepare the stipulation and to submit briefs, and states that Time Warner does not object.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and, in view of Time Warner's consent, finds it reasonable. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

The Commission notes that on December 6 it allowed the Missouri Independent Telephone Group and the Small Telephone Company Group to intervene. In that order, the Commission stated that MITG and STCG were bound by the Commission's November 14

order setting a procedural schedule. The Commission intends for all parties, including MITG and STCG, to follow the extended procedural schedule described below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion to Extend Procedural Schedule filed by the Staff of the Commission is granted.

2. That the following procedural schedule is now in effect:
