PROCEEDINGS

JUDGE PRIDGIN: We're on the record. Good morning. This is the prehearing conference LT-2006-0162 in the matter of Tariff No. 3 of Time Warner Cable Information Services of Missouri, LLC, doing business as Time Warner Cable.

I'm Ron Pridgin, I'm the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to preside over this case. We are here in the hotel Governor Office Building in Jefferson City, Missouri on October 27th, 2005. The time is about 10:05 a.m. We're here for a prehearing conference because of the Commission's October 18th Order Suspending Tariffs and Scheduling Prehearing Conference.

At this time, I would like to get oral entries of appearance from counsel beginning with Staff, please.

MS. WESTON: My name is Mary Weston. I'm here on behalf of Staff. My address is 200 Madison Street, Suite 800, Jefferson City, Missouri.

JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Weston, thank you. On behalf of Time Warner Cable Information Services, please.

MR. DEFORD: Paul S. DeFord with the law firm of Lathrop & Gage, 2345 Grand Boulevard, Kansas City, Missouri, 64108, appearing on behalf of Time Warner.

JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. DeFord. Thank you. I see no other counsel here. Is there any other counsel wishing to

1 make an appearance? All right. Seeing none, let me just  
2 briefly state that Mr. DeFord, if I'm not mistaken, you filed  
3 a Motion to Reconsider Suspension of Tariff on Tuesday the  
4 25th.

5 MR. DEFORD: That's correct.

6 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. And so Ms. Weston,  
7 I'm certainly going to give Staff time to reply to that  
8 motion. And I simply bring that out because I know that the  
9 proposed procedural schedule is due in a week, and if this  
10 motion somehow affects your timing, I'll just need somebody  
11 to please file a motion to extend the deadline, and I'd more  
12 than likely be glad to grant that. But I understand if  
13 dealing with this motion may affect when you're able to get a  
14 proposed procedural schedule, or indeed if you need to file  
15 one at all.

16 MS. WESTON: Okay. Thank you, Judge.

17 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Certainly. I'm not aware of  
18 any other pending motions, other than this Motion to  
19 Reconsider. Are there any other pending motions or anything  
20 else counsel needs to bring to my attention?

21 MS. WESTON: Not that I'm aware of.

22 MR. DEFORD: None, your Honor.

23 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Very good. Again,  
24 we certainly call these prehearing conferences to get you to  
25 get together on a proposed procedural schedule and hopefully

1 be able to resolve your disputes, so I'm going to step  
2 outside and let you talk.

3 I am up on the ninth floor if anybody has any  
4 questions. The calendar is also up on the ninth floor, and  
5 in case you didn't know, it's pretty darn crowded. So if  
6 you're looking for hearing dates, it may take awhile for you  
7 to find dates. I guess as soon as you decide if you think  
8 you do need a hearing, you better hustle up and grab a day or  
9 two, or however much you need on that calendar. Is there  
10 anything else that counsel needs from me?

11 MS. WESTON: No, Judge.

12 MR. DEFORD: No.

13 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. If there's nothing  
14 further, I will go off the record and let you talk. You'll  
15 have access to this room until five o'clock this afternoon.  
16 That will conclude the on the record portion of this  
17 prehearing conference in Case No. LT-2006-0162. Thank you.  
18 We're off the record.
