# MOTION TO ADOPT JOINTLY PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONSIDERATION OF NONUNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Missouri Retailers Association Office of Public Counsel, the Consumers Council of Missouri, and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (the "Consumer Parties"), and move for the Commission to their jointly proposed procedural schedule set forth herein for consideration of their nonunanimous stipulation. In support of their motion, the Consumer Parties state as follows:

- 1. On October 10, 2014, the Consumer Parties filed a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement ("Stipulation") requesting that the Commission adopt their proposal to provide rate relief to Noranda Aluminum, Inc. ("Noranda") subject to certain terms and conditions.
- 2. In order to prevent material rate increases to Ameren Missouri customers and irreparable harm to Missouri's economy, the Stipulation requests that the Commission issue an order making the proposed relief effective by December 31, 2014.
- 3. The Consumer Parties propose that the Commission adopt the following proposed procedural schedule for consideration of the Stipulation:

Direct Testimony October 24, 2014

Rebuttal Testimony November 10, 2014

Surrebuttal Testimony November 19, 2014

Evidentiary Hearings November 24 and November 25, 2014
