## MOTION TO FILE THIRD INTERIM REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for this Motion to File Third Interim Report states:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) established this case, for the purpose of receiving information from Kansas City Power & Light (KCPL) concerning the February 17, 1999 Hawthorn Station explosion, pursuant to Sections 393.130.1 and 393.140(1), (2), (3), (5), (9) and (10) RSMo (Supp. 1999).
- 2. On February 17, 1999, there was an explosion at KCPL's Hawthorn Station involving boiler number 5 in which the boiler was completely destroyed.
- 3. The Staff has initiated and pursued its investigation into the incident, but, for the reasons explained in the Third Interim Report, Staff's investigation is not yet complete.
  - 4. The Staff will file another report with the Commission in 120 days.

WHEREFORE the Staff requests that the Commission accept for filing this Third Interim Report concerning the February 17, 1999 Hawthorn 5 incident.
