1. 2. On February 17, 1999, there was an explosion at KCPL's Hawthorn Station involving boiler number 5 in which the boiler was completely destroyed.


3. The Staff has initiated and pursued its investigation into the incident, but, for the reasons explained in the Third Interim Report, Staff's investigation is not yet complete.


