MOTION FOR FINDING OF NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

COMES NOW the Director of the Department of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Director" and "Department"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's Office of General Counsel, and for his Motion For Finding of Necessity For Rulemaking ("Motion") states as follows:

- 1. Attached as attachment A is the Director's Recommendation to the Commission on the proposed rulemaking. There is no fiscal impact of the proposed rulemaking. The purpose of the rulemaking is to correct an incorrect statutory citation within the rule. This rulemaking will be effective in ensuring that the rule properly cites the statutory authority for the Public Service Commission ("Commission").
- 2. Monthly reporting requirements are authorized by RSMo §700.460 (1994). RSMo §700.460 (1994) also authorizes the Commission to promulgate rules on the information contained within the report, the manner in which dealers shall file the reports, and the form for the reports.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully requests that the Commission, based upon reasonably available empirical data including an assessment of the effectiveness and costs both

to the state and to any private or public person or entity affected, find that the proposed rulemaking, Rule 4 CSR 240-121.180 - Monthly Report Requirement for Registered Manufactured Home Dealers, is necessary to carry out the purposes of Section 700.460 RSMo (1994).
