Comes now Missouri Utilities Company, by and through its Court-Appointed Receiver, and for its Motion to Stay All Missouri Utilities Company Cases Until the Transfer to Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. is Complete, states to the Commission as follows:

1. As the Commission is aware, there are currently proceedings before the Commission, the basis of which is the failure of Missouri Utilities Company to file its Annual Reports.

The Receiver has previously filed his Motion to Set Aside Order Granting Motion for Default Termination which sets out the Receiver's response to the Staff's Motion for Default Determination.

- 2. As indicated in Receiver's Response, Missouri Utilities Company is in the process of selling the entirety of its assets to Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. Said application is on file and has been assigned Case No. SM-2017-0150.
- 3. Based upon the pending sale, the Receiver requests that the Commission stay all proceedings involving Missouri Utilities Company until such time as the sale is completed. At that point, all proceedings against Missouri Utilities Company would be moot.

WHEREFORE, Missouri Utilities Company prays that the Commission enter its Order staying all proceedings against and involving Missouri Utilities Company; and for such other and further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
