## APPLICATION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

**COMES NOW** ALLTEL Communications, Inc. (ALLTEL), by and through undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, and petitions the Commission to cancel the basic local exchange Certificate of Service Authority it granted to ALLTEL, as well as any approved basic local exchange tariffs of ALLTEL. In support of its application, ALLTEL respectfully states as follows:

1. In Case No. TA-99-298, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to ALLTEL to provide competitive basic local exchange services. (Report and Order issued September 2, 1999, effective September 14, 1999.) The Commission approved ALLTEL's basic local exchange tariff in the same case. (Order Approving Tariffs, issued August 7, 2000, effective August 14, 2000, approving ALLTEL'S MO P.S.C. Tariff No. 2 and MO P.S.C. Tariff No. 3.)

2. ALLTEL has no business, activity or customers in Missouri under this certificate of authority.

3. ALLTEL is a Delaware corporation with its principal offices located at One Allied Drive, P.O. Box 2177, Little Rock, Arkansas 72203-2177. ALLTEL is authorized by the Missouri Secretary of State to do business in Missouri. A copy of ALLTEL's Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in Missouri is on file, as a matter of public record, with this Commission. ALLTEL respectfully requests that the Commission take official notice of that certificate and incorporate it herein by reference pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G).

4. ALLTEL states that, to the best of its knowledge, it has no annual reports or assessment fees that are overdue. ALLTEL does not have any pending action or unsatisfied final judgments or decisions against it in any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision occurred within the last three (3) years.

5. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2005), which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, ALLTEL prays the Commission cancel the basic local exchange Certificate of Service Authority it granted to ALLTEL in Case No. TA-99-298, and to cancel any basic local exchange service tariffs of ALLTEL.
