MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES' APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("MDNR"), by and through counsel, and, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, respectfully requests that the Commission issue its order granting MDNR's Application to Intervene. For its Application, MDNR states as follows:

- 1. On July 5, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed a Motion to Approve Tariff to Suspend Payment of Solar Rebates and Motion for Expedited Treatment. GMO asks the Commission to approve the tariff no later than September 3. GMO's July 5 filing corresponds to the recent enactment of amendments to the Missouri Renewable Energy Standard, § 393.1030 RSMo, et.seq, effective August 28, 2013.
- 2. On July 9, 2013, the Commission issued an *Order Directing*Filing in File No. EO-2013-0505. No intervention deadline was set, but any party wishing to respond was required to do so no later than July 30, 2013.

 MDNR filed a response on July 30.

- 3. On August 1, 2013, the Commission issued an *Order Opening*Case to Consider Tariff. Parties in File No. EO-2013-0505 were not automatically made a party to the new case, ET-2014-0026.
- 4. On August 8, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Suspending

 Tariff and Setting Prehearing Conference.
- 5. MDNR, and specifically its Division of Energy, is a state agency vested with the powers and duties set forth in § 640.150 RSMo.
- 6. MDNR has an interest different than that of the general public, and its intervention will serve a public interest in that the Division of Energy will be looking at the proposed filing from a formal policy and planning perspective as well as looking at the potential impacts on environmental quality. The Division of Energy's review also will be in relation to the mandate set forth in § 640.150 RSMo, which includes planning for energy resource development; analyzing energy management issues; consulting and cooperating with all state and federal governmental agencies on matters of energy research and development, management, conservation and distribution; assessing the potential impacts on environmental quality; and analyzing the potential for increased use of energy alternatives and making recommendations for the expanded use of such alternate energy sources and technologies.
