MOTION TO DISMISS

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and moves that the above-captioned case number be dismissed from the docket of the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”), as the parties to the complaint have executed a Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”). In support of its *Motion*, Staff states the following:

1. On June 7, 2010, a formal complaint was filed with the Commission by Mr. Mike Medlin and Ms. Carol Medlin (hereafter collectively referred to as “Medlins” concerning a high water bill received from Raytown Water Co (“Company or Raytown”) possible.
2. On September 20, 2010, the parties and Staff participated in pre-hearing conference and privately discussed the matter after the pre-hearing conference. During this discussion, the parties were able to reach an agreement in principle that resolves this matter.
3. After several subsequent discussions related to the agreement, the parties to this formal complaint, the Medlins and Raytown, have reached a Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) that resolves all issues related to this complaint.

4. On October 11, 2010, Staff received a copy of an executed Agreement from Raytown signed by its counsel, Mr. Ron Spradley.

5. On October 19, 2010, Staff received an executed Agreement from the Medlins signed by Mike Medlin and Carol Medlin.

6. After review, Staff believes both parties are satisfied with the Agreement and the Agreement addresses the substantive issues related to the formal complaint. As a result, Staff believes dismissal is appropriate.

7. The Medlins and Raytown agreed that Staff would file this *Motion* on behalf of all parties involved. Staff hereby states that the complaint involved in Case No. WC-2010-0357 has been mutually resolved and all parties involved desire that the matter be dismissed.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the Commission dismiss this formal complaint and close this matter, as the complaint has been resolved to the satisfaction of all parties and all parties have agreed to request the matter be dismissed.
