ORDER REQUIRING FILING

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]11 public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year¹."

On April 28, 2000, KLM Telephone Company (KLM) filed its first motion for an extension of time to file its annual report. KLM stated that although it had made a diligent effort to complete the report for submission by April 15, 2000, it was not possible for KLM to file a complete and accurate report by that date. KLM stated that due to the elimination of the primary toll carrier plan and the institution of dialing parity in its exchanges, there had been changes in the sources of its revenues and in its accounting. These changes, KLM stated, caused the preparation of its annual report to be delayed. KLM requested an extension up to May 15, 2000, in which to complete and file its annual report.



¹ April 15, 2000, was on a Saturday, thus effectively making the due date the following Monday, i.e., April 17, 2000.

On May 15, 2000, KLM filed its second motion on the same grounds as the first motion for extension of time to May 30, 2000, to file its annual report. On May 30, 2000, KLM filed its third motion on the same grounds as the first and second motions for extension of time to June 15, 2000, to file its annual report.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3) states, in part: "Each pleading shall include a...specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which relief is requested." None of KLM's motions complied with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3) in that they did not include a specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which relief was requested.

KLM will be ordered to cure these deficiencies.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That KLM Telephone Company shall file, no later than 3:00 p.m. on June 22, 2000, a supplemental pleading which includes a specific reference to the statutory provision or other authority under which it requested relief in its three motions to late file its annual report.

2. That this order shall become effective on June 22, 2000.
