## AMEREN MISSOURI'S NOTICE OF CORRECTION OF TYPO IN AGREED UPON IN-SERVICE CRITERIA UNDER CONDITION c FROM COMMISSION'S CCN ORDER

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company"), and provides notice of correction of a typo in the agreed upon in-service criteria under Condition c from the Commission's CCN Order. In support hereof, the Company respectfully states as follows:

1. On July 16, 2021, the Company filed it *Notice of Compliance with Conditions a and c from Commission's CCN Order*. With regard to condition c of the CCN Order, the Company's *Notice* included Exhibit C, which contained the in-service criteria agreed upon with Staff.

2. Subsequently, the Company realized that Exhibit C contained a typo in Attachment 1 for the definition of "Design Point Conditions." Specifically, for the ambient reference conditions stated in such definition, the solar irradiance should have been 1000 watts per meter square instead of 1050 watts per meter square.

3. The Company confirmed with Staff that the typo in Exhibit C should be corrected, and hereby files the corrected Exhibit C to fix the typo.
