MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire" or "Company"), by and through counsel, and for its Motion for Reconsideration respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

1. By its Order Modifying Procedural Schedule issued in this case on August 24, 2012, the Commission directed Empire, by January 15, 2013, to file additional testimony concerning, generally, a possible "rate stabilization mechanism". Other parties to the case were also authorized to file additional testimony on this topic. Similar requirements were also imposed by the Commission in the pending rate cases involving Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Kansas City Power & Light Company.

2. Subsequently, in response to requests by the Office of the Public Counsel and other parties to the Ameren and Kansas City Power & Light rate cases, the Commission reconsidered and vacated its orders in those cases directing the parties to file testimony concerning the rate stabilization issue. Additionally, by order issued September 20, 2012 in Case No. AW-2013-0110, the Commission created a "working docket" to consider the establishment of rate stabilization mechanisms to reduce the need for frequent rate case filings and afforded interested utilities and others the opportunity to file comments.

3. Given the fact that the exploration of rate stabilization proposals will be conducted in the AW-2013-0110 docket and given the fact that the requirement to address this topic has been vacated from the Ameren and Kansas City Power & Light rate cases, Empire believes that it would be appropriate for and desires that the Commission reconsider and vacate its August 24, 2012 Order Modifying Procedural Schedule issued in the captioned-proceeding thereby relieving Empire and the other parties to this case from the necessity of addressing the rate stabilization issue in this proceeding.

4. The Office of the Public Counsel and Midwest Energy Consumers Group have indicated that they support this Motion. An advance copy of this Motion has been provided to the other parties to this case and none have indicated any objection to the relief requested herein.

WHEREFORE, Empire moves the Commission to grant the relief stated in paragraph 3 supra.
