MOTION TO SCHEDULE HEARING ON FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER ISSUES

COME NOW The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") and the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel"), and for their motion respectfully state as follows:

- 1. On May 14, 2001, Empire, Staff and Public Counsel filed a "Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Fuel and Purchased Power Expense" in this case.
- 2. On May 18, 2001, counsel for Praxair, Inc., who was not a party to the May 14 Stipulation and Agreement on Fuel and Purchased Power Issues, sent a letter to the parties and the Commission in which it says that Praxair opposes the Stipulation and requests a hearing on all issues comprehended under it.
- 3. The "Proposed List of Issues, List of Witnesses and Order of Cross Examination" filed in this case on May 14, 2001, contemplated the possibility of Praxair requesting such a hearing. The parties indicated that Wednesday, June 6, 2001, was "reserved" for that and other potential purposes.
- 4. Empire and Public Counsel therefore request that the Commission issue an order which indicates that the Commission will hear the issues involved with fuel and purchased power, including the Stipulation and Agreement, beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 6,

2001. Under that procedure, Empire, the Staff, and Public Counsel intend to call their witnesses to stand cross examination on their pre-filed testimony. In addition, there will be additional witnesses called for parties who chose to file prepared testimony in support of the Stipulation and Agreement, and they will be available for cross-examination also. The granting of this motion will provide some certainty to the parties as to when to make their witnesses available.

5. The Staff was consulted prior to the filing of this motion and has no objection to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Empire and Public Counsel request that the Commission issue an order which designates Wednesday, June 6, 2001, beginning at 8:30 a.m., as the time for the Commission to consider the fuel and purchased power issues and the Stipulation and Agreement on those issues.
