ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE AN EXPEDITED
RECOMMENDATION

On April 4, 2006, McDonald County Telephone Company filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment regarding a tariff that it filed with its motion. The motion explains that McDonald County Telephone has filed a tariff that will allow it to add a new custom calling service and two new customer calling packages. The motion indicates that McDonald County Telephone did not file the tariff sheets earlier because there was an unavoidable delay in their preparation. The tariff indicates that it will take effect on May 4, but McDonald County Telephone requests that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on May 1, 2006, because its marketing plan for the new service and package is scheduled to begin on May 1.

If the Commission is to act on McDonald County Telephone's request for expedited approval of its tariff, it will need to have an expedited recommendation from its Staff.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation, or an explanation of when it will be able to file a recommendation, regarding McDonald County Telephone

Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment, and its accompanying tariff, no later than April 14, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on April 6, 2006.
