COMES NOW, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and hereby responds to the Commission's *Order Directing Notice and Order Directing Responses to Application*, which was issued on February 2, 2016. KCP&L states:

- 1. On February 1, 2016, Gerald Fuemmeler submitted an application for approval to change electrical supplier in order to serve grain bins requiring three-phase electrical service, located in Salisbury, Missouri.
- 2. KCP&L does not object to this transfer. Under the unique circumstances of this situation, KCP&L concurs with the request to allow the City of Salisbury to serve Mr. Fuemmeler's structures requiring three-phase electrical service.
- 3. KCP&L wishes to clarify one issue associated with Mr. Fuemmeler's application. A letter authored by Scott Stefankiewicz on behalf of Gerald Fuemmeler was attached to the application with an explanation of the request for change of electric supplier. The letter states that KCP&L communicated to Messrs. Stefankiewicz and Fuemmeler the project would cost nearly \$1 million to bring three-phase power to the property. KCP&L quoted Mr. Fuemmeler a project cost estimate that did not include taxes of approximately **
