Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) submits the following response to the June 30, 2017 *Staff’s Report of MEEIA Prudence Review* (“KCP&L Staff Report”) for consideration by the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in the above-captioned docket.

1. KCP&L agrees with Staff’s recommendation that the “...Commission order an adjustment to flow back to ratepayers in the amount of \$4,723 in KCP&L’s next Rider DSIM rate adjustment filing to correct errors made in the calculation of KCP&L’s performance incentive award amount for the Cycle 1.”¹
