**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF TARIFF
SHEETS FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

COMES NOW Missouri Gas Energy. ("MGE"), by and through counsel, and for its Motion for Expedited Consideration and Approval of Tariff Sheets Filed in Compliance with Commission Order, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission"):

1. On August 7, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement ("Order") approving a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement ("Agreement") addressing new natural gas conservation programs to be administered by MGE. Attached to the Agreement were agreed-to specimen tariff sheets. Among other things, the Order directed MGE to file revised tariff sheets identical to the specimen tariff sheets. The Order is silent, however, as to the effective date to be included.

2. On this date, MGE has caused to be filed with the Commission revised tariff sheets designed to carry out the implementation aspects of the Order. Those revised tariff sheets bear an issued date of today, August 8, 2007, and an effective date of September 7, 2007, thirty days thereafter. They have been assigned a tracking number of YG-2008-0099.

3. MGE does not believe that thirty days' notice is necessary or appropriate inasmuch as the Commission already has considered the specimen tariff sheets filed as

attachments to the Agreement and found them to be reasonable and appropriate by directing that MGE file them "expeditiously". Consequently, MGE requests that the Commission allow the tariff sheets to go into effect on August 13, 2007.

4. Moreover, there are no notice/due process implications associated with making the tariff sheets effective immediately in that the Company's proposal for implementing natural gas conservation programs has been a matter of public record since July 30, 2007, when it filed the tariff sheets later rejected by order of the Commission.

5. Finally, MGE believes it is important that its customers be given the opportunity to use these tools to control their natural gas commodity costs without any additional unnecessary delay.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, MGE respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Consideration and Approval of Tariff Sheets Filed in Compliance with Commission Order and approve the tariff sheets MGE has filed to be effective on and after August 13, 2007.
