**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

**COMES NOW** Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of Confluence Rivers’ tariff sheets (YS-2023-0066) filed on October 10, 2022:

1. On September 14, 2022, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* in the above captioned case. The *Order*, among other things, directed Confluence Rivers to revise P.S.C. MO No. 13 for the addition of Deer Run’s sewer assets, to become effective before closing on the assets.

2. Confluence Rivers seeks to close on the assets of Deer Run during the first week of November 2022.

3. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, Confluence Rivers has filed tariff sheets consistent with the Commission’s *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity*. These tariff sheets carry proposed effective date of November 9, 2022 (30 days) and have been assigned tracking number YS-2023-0066.

5. Confluence Rivers hereby seeks the Commission’s order allowing the proposed tariff sheets to go into effect on less than thirty days notice on November 1, 2022.


6. A grant of this motion will further the public interest. As indicated in the Staff’s

recommendation and the Commission's *Order Granting Certificate of Necessity and Convenience*, the sewer system requires repairs and upgrades to continue to provide safe and reliable sewer service to existing and future customers. Thus, the sooner Confluence Rivers is able to close on the subject assets, the sooner it may address those issues. Addressing these tariff sheets in an expedited manner will reduce the time customers in the subject service areas will have to wait before the subject systems are updated. Conversely, there will be no negative effect on party customers or the general public by approving the tariff sheets prior to closing on the first week of November 2022.

7. The tariff sheets and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the Commission issued its *Order* directing the tariff sheets to become effective before closing on the subject assets, subsequent preparation of the subject sheets, and an understanding of what closing date would be possible.

**WHEREFORE**, for the foregoing reasons, Confluence Rivers respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve Confluence Rivers' proposed tariff sheets (YS-2023-0066) to be effective as of November 1, 2022.


