- 1. On April 14, 2000, the Staff inadvertently filed in this docket a Motion to Close Case that pertains to another docket. Staff hereby requests to withdraw said April 14th Motion and substitute its Memorandum.

Staff's Recommendation for Approval of Annual Report Extension Filing

On March 24, 2000, GTE Midwest Incorporated - Iowa Operations filed a letter requesting an extension of thirty (30) days to file their 1999 Annual Report. The Company's reason for an extension is due to the Joint Application now pending before the Missouri Public Service Commission in Case No. TM-2000-403 in which the Company proposes to sell all 296 of GTE's local telephone exchanges located in the State of Iowa, three of which include approximately 105 access lines that serve customers physically located in Missouri. The extension will allow for complete and proper preparation of the Annual Report.

The Company's request was forwarded to the following employees to see if they had any objections to granting the request: Ron Bible, Cary Featherstone, Denny Frey, Janet Hoerschgen, John Van Eschen. Greg Meyer, Mark Oligschlaeger, Steve Rackers, Joan Wandel and Lisa Kremer. No objections to the request were received.
