## MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company ("Liberty" or "Company"), and on behalf of itself, the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel, submits this Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule for consideration by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

1. On May 21, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Rejecting Tariff to Change Fuel Adjustment Rates*, effective May 31, 2020. In that *Order*, the Commission directed the parties to submit a proposed procedural schedule by no later than June 18, 2020.

2. The parties suggested a procedural schedule, and, on June 24, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*. The items remaining are as follows:
