**JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING**

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission), on behalf of Cathedral Square Corporation (CSC), Kansas City Power & Light Company, and the Office of the Public Counsel (collectively, Parties) and pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(2) hereby states:

1. This case is set for evidentiary hearing at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 17, 2012, pursuant to the Commission's *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*, filed January 19, 2012.
2. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110 provides "[t]he presiding officer may order continuance of a hearing date for good cause."
3. In this case, the Parties have agreed, in principle, to the terms of a settlement. The Parties need additional time to draft and execute a Stipulation and Agreement; however, the Parties expect to timely resolve this case by filing a Stipulation and Agreement for the Commission's approval.
4. Good cause exists because a continuance will allow the Parties time to resolve the case through a Stipulation and Agreement.
5. The Parties all agree to request this continuance.

**WHEREFORE** Staff, on behalf of the Parties, hereby moves the Commission to continue the hearing of this matter for 60 days.
