MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Aquila, Inc. (“Aquila”) and on behalf of itself and the other parties to this case, requests that the Commission modify the Procedural Schedule in one respect. In support thereof, Aquila states the following:

1. On January 23, 2008, the Commission, at the request of the parties, issued an Order Modifying Procedural Schedule pursuant to which it established dates for various filings and events. Among other things, the Commission scheduled the evidentiary hearing to commence on April 14 and to continue through April 16, 2008.

2. The parties had requested that the hearing on April 14, 2008, commence at 10:00 a.m., to accommodate for travel time for a number of the parties of record. Subsequent discussions among the parties at the March 3, 2008, prehearing conference revealed a number of witness availability limitations which are noted in the List of Issues, and Order of Opening Statements, Witnesses and Cross-Examination filed on March 7, 2008.¹ To accommodate those witnesses, the parties are of the view that it would be both feasible and

advantageous to commence the hearing on the first day, April 14, 2008, at 8:30 a.m., instead of 10:00 a.m. No other modification to the procedural schedule is requested.

3. Aquila has discussed this request with the other parties of record and is authorized to represent that this targeted change to the procedural schedule is acceptable to all concerned.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons aforesaid, Aquila requests that the Commission modify the procedural schedule in this case such that the evidentiary hearing on April 14, 2008, commences at 8:30 a.m. instead of 10:00 a.m.
