THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S UPDATE TO MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and for its Update to Motion to Compel Discovery states as follows:

- 1. On January 17, 2014, Public Counsel filed a Motion to Compel Discovery asking the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to compel Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Company, Inc. (Hickory Hills) to fully and completely respond to data requests Public Counsel sent to Hickory Hills on December 6, 2013, which are significantly overdue.
- 2. On January 21, 2014, the Commission issued an order requiring Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Company, Inc. to respond to Public Counsel's motion no later than January 23, 2014. The Order also stated that any other party may file a response to Public Counsel's motion by that same date.
- 3. On January 22, 2014, Public Counsel received a letter (See Attached) from Hickory Hills via email which purported to respond to Public Counsel's data requests. While the letter does provide at least a cursory response to many of Public Counsel's data requests, several of the responses say merely "attached" or "see attached." The letter also indicates that enclosures were

intended to go along with the letter. However, no attachments were provided. An email from the below signed attorney to Mr. Cover asking if the attachments had been mistakenly omitted went unanswered.

4. Therefore, as an update to its Motion to Compel, Public Counsel now informs the Commission that Hickory Hills has provided a response to many of its data requests. However, without the stated attachments, Public Counsel continues to have no response to its December 6, 2013, data request numbers 1101, 1107, 1109, 1122, 1123, 1124, 1125 and 1126. Public Counsel renews its Motion to Compel Discovery as to these unanswered data requests.

WHEREFORE, the Office of the Public Counsel offers this update and respectfully requests that the Commission issue an Order to Compel Responses to Public Counsel's December 6, 2013, unanswered data requests, in full and completely, within seven (7) days of an order by the Commission or as soon as practicable, and for such other and additional relief that is necessary and proper.
