**MOTION TO AMEND ORDER *NUNC PRO TUNC*
TO CORRECT A TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR**

Under authority of and in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.080, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "the Company") moves the Commission to amend its February 10, 2016, *Order Approving Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* to correct a typographical error. Page 4 of the order states, in relevant part, "the Earnings Opportunity ("EO") is only \$24.7 million." As stated in Section 13.c and as shown in Appendix A of the non-unanimous stipulation, the agreed upon earnings objective (assuming a 100 percent payout) is \$27,471,935, which when rounded is \$27.5 million.

WHEREFORE, to avoid confusion between the earnings objective stated in the Commission's order and that agreed to by signatories to the stipulation, Ameren Missouri requests the order be amended *nunc pro tunc* to read as follows: "the Earnings Opportunity ("EO") is only \$27.5 million."
