**KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY’S  
NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL  
OF ITS PROPOSAL TO USE FORECASTED EXPENSES OR A TRACKER  
FOR CIP/CYBERSECURITY COMPLIANCE COSTS**

Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L” or “Company”), and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(18), files this Notice with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for the purpose of notifying the Commission and the parties of record that it is withdrawing its request for the use of forecasted non-labor operations and maintenance expense levels and/or a tracker for critical infrastructure protection (“CIP”) and cyber-security compliance costs for purposes of this case. In support, KCP&L states as follows:

1. On July 1, 2016, KCP&L filed an Application and tariffs initiating a general rate case to review its request for an increase in rates in its service area in Missouri. The Application and supporting testimony included a request for forward-looking rate treatment (i.e. use of forecasted non-labor operations and maintenance expense levels and/or a tracker) for CIP and cyber-security compliance costs. (See Direct Testimony of Darrin R. Ives, pp. 18-21; Direct Testimony of Tim Rush, pp. 14-15; Direct Testimony of Joshua Phelps-Roper, pp. 1-10)

2. In light of a recent moderation in the level of increases in CIP/cyber-security compliance costs, KCP&L hereby withdraws its request for forward-looking rate treatment, including the use of forecasted non-labor operations and maintenance expense levels or a tracker for CIP/cyber-security compliance costs for purposes of this case.

**WHEREFORE**, KCP&L respectfully withdraws its request for forward looking treatment of CIP/Cybersecurity costs, as more fully explained herein, in this proceeding.
