AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION

COMES NOW Applicant, The Raytown Water Company ("RWC"), by and through counsel, and makes the following Amendment to its Application filed to its Application filed with the Commission on or about November 23, 2021. RWC has just learned through its bankers and the proposed issuer of the bonds that interest rates may have changed since the Application was filed and that interest rates may change in the future. Therefore, RWC amends its Application, paragraph 7, to delete the original paragraph and insert this new paragraph 7:

7. A brief description of the securities Applicant desires to issue is as follows: Water Facilities Refunding and Improvement Bonds in a principal sum not to exceed \$5,000,00000 or less, each bearing initial interest at a rate not to exceed Four Percent (4.0%) per annum, all maturing on twenty (20) years from the date of any Order approving this Application, approximately, June 1, 2042 (the "Maturity"), with interest to be paid on June 1, 2022, semi-annually thereafter and principal payments to be made on June 1, 2023 and annually thereafter, all accrued and unpaid interest and remaining balance of unpaid principal to be paid at maturity. The Bonds are to be issued as an Additional Obligation under, subject to and secured by the lien of, that certain Deed of Trust, Mortgage and Security Agreement pursuant to the Bond Trust Indenture and Loan Agreement among the Applicant, the Mortgage Trustee and the Missouri Environmental Improvement and Energy Resources Authority ("EIERA")(the "Authority"). The bonds will be

issued as Series 2022 bonds, depending on the year in which they are issued, within three (3) years of the date of the Order of the Commission authorizing the issue of the Bonds becomes a final Order or decision.

In all other respects, the Application originally filed with the Commission shall be adopted as though fully set forth herein.

WHEREFORE, Applicant The Raytown Water Company, respectfully requests that the Commission issue an Order or decision authorizing Applicant to issue the above-described securities for the specific purposes as stated in its original Application.
