The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued October 15, 2010 to become effective on and after November 1, 2010.

These revised sheets include changes to the Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors for the Company's four Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, result from the combination of a decrease in the weighted average cost of gas and an increase in the ACA component. The firm sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 71.00¢/Ccf to 73.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 56.80¢/Ccf to 54.42¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area is the result of a combination of an increase in the weighted average cost of gas and a decrease in the ACA component. The firm sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 87.00¢/Ccf to 84.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 58.05¢/Ccf to 55.67¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

Workpapers supporting this filing are available on CaseWorks. Certain of the workpapers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
