NOTICE TO THE COMMISSION

COMES NOW UtiliCorp United Inc. ("UtiliCorp") and advises the Commission with respect to the status of its acquisition of the Midlands Business¹ in light of the sudden collapse of Enron Corp. ("Enron").

Midlands, through its wholly owned subsidiary Midlands Power International Limited, holds a twenty-seven percent (27%) interest in Teesside Power Ltd. ("Teesside"), a power generation project located in the UK. Teesside has significant long-term power sales contracts with Enron. Discussions are continuing between the current owners of Teesside, various banks, Enron and others, in an attempt to resolve the situation. However, it now appears possible that dividends to the owners of Teesside will be eliminated for an extended period of time.

This development could result in the withdrawal of UtiliCorp's prospective Partner, Deutsche Bank, from the transaction. In the absence of a Partner, UtiliCorp would be placed in the position of acquiring one hundred percent (100%) of the outstanding shares of Avon. This would cause significant changes to the financial information UtiliCorp filed on November 19, 2001, as <u>Appendix 6</u> (substitute) to the <u>Application</u>.

In light of the uncertainty that these recent events have caused, UtiliCorp understands that the Commission may wish to further condition its approval of the

Application that UtiliCorp have a Partner with which to participate in the acquisition in the manner described in the Application. By so doing, the Commission can ensure that the debt of Midlands and Avon will not be consolidated on UtiliCorp's financial statements, and that UtiliCorp's financial ratios will be similar to those shown in Appendix 6 as filed.

With respect to the timing for the issuance of a Commission order in this case, UtiliCorp's <u>Application</u> requested that the Commission issue an order by December 15, 2001, bearing an effective date of no later than December 25, 2001. UtiliCorp renews its request for expedited Commission approval of the <u>Application</u>, subject to the conditions heretofore recommended by the Commission's Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel and the additional condition noted in the immediately preceding paragraph.

WHEREFORE, UtiliCorp notifies the Commission of changes in the circumstances surrounding its <u>Application</u> to acquire the outstanding shares of Avon and renews its request for an order approving the <u>Application</u> subject to the conditions recommended by Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel and, also, subject to the condition that UtiliCorp have a Partner as described in paragraphs 8 and 12 of the <u>Application</u>.
