On December 19, 2016, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water and sewer system in and around the Village of Wardsville, in Cole County, Missouri. The requested certificates would allow MAWC to provide water and sewer service in the Village of Wardsville and the surrounding area. The Commission will direct notice be given and set deadlines for intervention requests and Staff recommendations.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Cole County, Missouri, and to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall also provide a copy of this order to the ten residents or land owners listed in Appendix B-HC of the application without making that list open to the public.
3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Cole County, Missouri, and to the media serving Cole County, Missouri.
4. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than January 11, 2017.
5. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendations regarding Missouri-American Water Company's applications no later than February 10, 2017.
6. This order shall be effective when issued.
