
1. The Company has main offices in Missouri located at 941 Charter Commons, Town & Country, 63017.



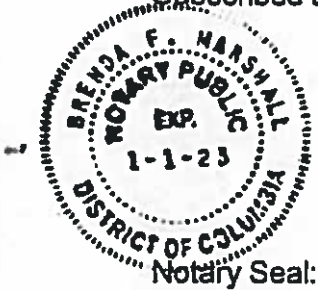
