MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COME NOW WorldCom, Inc. ("WorldCom"), MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. ("MCI WorldCom") and Intermedia Communications Inc. ("Intermedia") (hereinafter "Applicants") and for their Motion for Expedited Treatment state to the Commission as follows:

1. Applicants have herein filed an Application for approval of a transfer of customers between affiliated entities, with a waiver of Rule 4 CSR 240-33.150. The benefits of the proposed transaction are described in the Application.
2. The Application was filed as soon as possible.
3. Applicants seek to make the transfer on July 15, 2002. In order to complete the transaction as planned, Applicants seek Commission approval by July 14, 2002.
4. Expedited approval of the proposed transaction will afford the benefits thereof in a timely fashion to the involved companies, their customers, and shareholders, as well as to the Commission.
5. As shown in their Application, there will be no negative effect on Applicants' customers or the general public if the Commission acts as soon as possible and grants the requested relief.

WHEREFORE, Applicants respectfully request the Commission to expedite its handling of the Application on this case and grant the relief requested therein by July 14, 2002.
