- 3. As MPGA has voluntarily dismissed all other issues from the Complaint, the factual determination as to what are the applicable manufacturers' specifications relating to the conversion of appliances is the only outstanding issue in the Complaint that needs to be resolved.
- 4. 4 CSR 240-2.090(4) provides:

Any party may petition the commission to hold a prehearing conference at any time prior to the hearing.
