At a session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 21st day of September, 1999.

In the Matter of Laclede Gas Company's Tariff) Case No. GR-99-315 to Revise Natural Gas Rate Schedules.

ORDER ESTABLISHING TRUE-UP AUDIT AND HEARING

Laclede Gas Company (Laclede), the Staff of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) filed a Joint Motion for a True-Up Audit and Hearing on August 18, 1999. The movants requested that the Commission order a true-up audit and hearing to recognize in Laclede's rates several items including:

- (a) revenues associated with customer changes as of August 1, 1999;
- (b) rate base component changes and associated depreciation and property taxes as of August 1, 1999;
- (c) capital structure changes for long-term debt, short-term debt, preferred stock and common equity;
- (d) changes in employee levels and benefits costs, including costs associated with the August 1, 1999, contract wage increases for union employees in the Laclede and Missouri Natural Divisions, and changes in management salaries;
- (e) the effect of any change in the Commission's annual assessment for fiscal year 2000;
- (f) costs associated with maintenance agreements for computer systems which are in service;

- (g) changes in rate case expenses;
- (h) verifiable cost changes associated with the calculable increases in facility locates;
- (i) changes in deferred balances and amortizations associated with the tracking mechanisms and accounting authorizations granted to Laclede in its last two rate case proceedings, based on the parties' positions on this issue.¹

The Commission ordered that a test year ending December 31, 1998, be used and that the test year be updated through March 31, 1999. The movants recommended a true-up audit and hearing be held in late September; however, at the evidentiary hearing the parties agreed that October 7, 1999, would be an appropriate date. The Commission will therefore order that true-up testimony and schedules be filed and a true-up hearing be held as set out below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a true-up audit shall be conducted through August 31, 1999.
- 2. That true-up testimony and schedules shall be filed no later than October 1, 1999.
- 3. That a true-up hearing is scheduled for October 7, 1999, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in the Commission's

hearing room on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.

 - 5. That this order shall become effective on October 1, 1999.


