## MOTION TO RESCHEDULE PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DATE FOR FILING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Oregon Farmers Mutual Telephone Company (Company) and for its Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference and Date for Filing Procedural Schedule, states to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) as follows:

- 1. On December 20, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Granting
  Reconsideration, Suspending Tariff, Directing Notice, Directing Filing, Scheduling Prehearing
  Conference, and Establishing Protective Order in the above-referenced matter. In that Order, the
  Commission, among other things, established a Prehearing Conference for January 12, 2000, and
  directed the parties to file a proposed Procedural Schedule no later than January 23, 2001.
- 2. Counsel for Company has scheduled a meeting with clients out of town on January 12, 2000. That meeting was established prior to December 20, 2000, and, unfortunately, it involves a number of people and cannot be easily rescheduled.
